



# PRESENTING THE BROWSE BIN

In a spirit of innovative thinking, the Show Committee is extending an offer to participants in the upcoming January 2022 Lakeside show to bring a canvas browse bin with them while they are sitting with the exhibit.

## Rules for Bin Artwork

Original paintings and prints will be allowed in your browse bin. All work on paper must be matted and encased in plastic for a good appearance and to protect the artwork while being handled. Canvas prints on stretcher bars need not be encased in plastic.

Each Print must be clearly labeled "PRINT" and originals marked as "ORIGINAL" so that the buyer is aware of what they are purchasing.

Each artist is allowed only one bin.

## Location of the Bin

Your bin must be placed at the end of the JAG show table where the Artist is sitting and **MUST BE REMOVED** when the Artist's sitting period has ended. If you wish to work an additional shift you may do so with your Browse Bin. You will be expected to perform the regular sitting duties.

While we realize not all of our members have prints made of their work, if you do the browse bin may allow you to expand your sales. This is a trial. It may work, it may not. If it proves to be too cumbersome or controversial we will not continue with it.

*Just a reminder that PRINTS are never allowed to hang on screens in a JAG show; only original artwork.*
